

### What is the state wide Come & Try event?

The 'Motorcycling Queensland Come & Try event' is an opportunity for any rider, who has never held any type of annual riding licence through the organisation, to come and give motorcycling 'a go' in a safe, controlled and cost-effective environment at one of the participating club's venues.

### When can I run a Come & Try event?

An affiliated Motorcycling Queensland Club can run as many Come & Try events as they wish each year. The MQ Office will not be able to facilitate any Come and Try events until the weekend of January 20 & 21, 2018.

### What's on Offer?

- Come & Try permit issued FREE of charge to clubs
- No licence fee for riders to participate
- No rider levies charged by MQ to participating clubs
- Legitimate NEW riders that participate in the event have the option to get a FREE Introductory 90-day Rec/Mini Licence. Riders must apply to Motorcycling QLD through the Come and Try Licence application form that will be included in the packs sent out to each club that registers. They MUST include, proof of age and the Come and Try Licence issued on the day.
- MQ will develop and maintain a dedicated 'tab' on our webpage – [www.mqld.org.au](http://www.mqld.org.au) promoting a State-wide calendar of Come & Try events
- MQ will develop a template media release for clubs to modify for their purposes
- MQ will develop a promotional poster for use by clubs

### What are the benefits to the club?

The main benefits to participating clubs are:

- utilising this event as a way of attracting new members/participants
- local area promotion of your club, its activities and the motorcycling in general

### How does my club register to conduct a Come & Try event?

#### 4 Weeks before the event.

**Step 1.** Apply via Ridernet, for a Come & Try permit

**Step 2.** Complete and return to MQ the MQ Come & Try application form with relevant information.

**Step 3.** MQ will then post your required come and try licence books and MQ Come and Try Licence application forms. MQ will also email you the template media release and promotional poster.

**Step 4.** Commence promotion of your event in your local area

### What to do after the Come & Try Event? (within 7 days)

- Send back the come and try report
- Send back the come and try licence books (used and un-used)

**Please note** – Applying for the FREE 90-day Introductory REC/MINI licence is the responsibility of the rider not the club. Please provide the Rider with the application form and come and try licence so they can complete the process themselves.
