PLEASE MAKE YOURSELF FAMILIAR WITH SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS AS WELL AS FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

ADMISSION - Entry to the venue will be from 3:00pm Friday afternoon (General Admission) and 12.00pm (Sponsored Sites). There were a number of vehicles trying to enter before allocated time at previous rounds, this has caused problems with council by blocking access to the public. This will not be tolerated – if you turn up prior to 3pm you will be allocated a pit site at the back of the pit area. If directions can not be followed then penalties may apply to your rider.

PIT AREA Please note that parking in the sponsored pit sites is strictly forbidden unless you are the owner of that pit site. If you are unsure of your correct location, please ask before setting up. Please note that it is a requirement for enclosed footwear to be worn at all times in the pit area.

CAMPING - Camping on Friday and Saturday night is permitted. Hot Showers are available. Please keep shower time to a minimum. Please keep the facilities clean. Anyone found vandalising any of the club's property will be penalised. A \$10 Camping Fee will apply and can be paid at the entry gate or paid to club volunteers collecting fees.

- All generators and music must be turned off by 10:00pm. Children under 16 must be at their own camp by 8:30pm.
- Please keep noise to a minimum for the quiet enjoyment of all campers.
- Strictly no fires** as there is a total fire ban in place.
- Dumping of waste from van toilets is not permitted at the club – please use proper dump points.**

SIGN ON - Competitors will be required to present their Competition Licence & Logbook (in the case of Juniors), to the sign on personnel. Please make sure your endorsement is up to date. Programs and hired transponders will be issued at this stage. Any issues with entries not yet finalised will be done so here by the Race Secretary.

SCRUTINEERING - Will be held inside fenced area beside start straight. Machines, helmet, back numbers, boots, body armour (for Juniors) and any spare machines must be presented for scrutineering. **BACK NUMBERS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL RIDERS. ALL BIKE NUMBERS MUST BE CLEAR, LARGE AND PLEASE CONSIDER PLACEMENT OF NUMBERS – WHEN THE RIDER IS IN STANDING POSITION OF THE BIKE MAKE SURE HIS LEG DOES NOT COVER THE NUMBERS** and be consistent with MOMS 12.15. For all riders, parent's and support persons, please remember that enclosed footwear must be worn at scrutineering.

TRANSPONDERS – Competitors hiring transponders will be required to exchange their MA licence. If you have your own transponder please ensure it is registered, fully charged and activated. You will need a bracket – these can be purchased at sign on for \$10. Please see sup regs for details of transponder hire terms etc. The transponder must be fitted for practice and all races. Hired transponder must be returned at the end of the race day to the timing tent. Provisional Results will be displayed at the timing tent throughout the day which will be located near the tower. Should you have any queries on your results during the day, please see the Race Secretary immediately. Please do not wait until the end of day or day after to raise queries.

TEAR OFFS – Tear Offs will be permitted to be used. It is a requirement that any tear offs removed in the pit areas are immediately placed in rubbish bins. At the finalisation of race day, it is encouraged that kids walk the track and collect any tear offs. Please note however, that no persons are allowed on the track if machinery is present. Please ensure you listen for instructions on when to enter the track. Failure to ensure all tear offs are removed from the track, pits and surrounding areas would be a breach of our Environmental Plan and may mean that the decision to run tear off's in the future would be reversed.

RIDERS BRIEFING - Will be held in pit board area, on grass next to start gates. The PA system is not permitted to be used before 8am so it is up to riders to be at riders briefing on time at 7:40am. The first practice group is requested to push their bikes at the start gate area and riders are to proceed to briefing. All riders and their guardians for juniors must attend Riders Briefing. A role call WILL be done with Penalties for riders not there at the start of the Briefing. ROLL CALL WILL BE AT 7.45am.

GUARDIANSHIP FORMS - If any rider under 18 years of age is attending without their parent or legal guardian they must provide a completed Temporary Guardianship Form to the Race Secretary before entering the track.

SOUND TESTING - May be carried out. All machines must comply with the current MOM's for noise emissions.

NOISE CURFEW - No Machine is to be started prior to 8:00am or after 5pm and no PA system can be used before 8:00am – this is a ruling from council and must be strictly adhered to.

CANTEEN - Saturday and Sunday for breakfast and lunch. A pizza van will be coming in Friday and Saturday night for catering night time meals.

ALCOHOL & SMOKING - The carrying of and or consumption of alcoholic beverages by **any** person with the pit or paddock area is strictly prohibited. Smoking is not permitted within 10 metres from the viewing fence or surrounding canteen area. Smoking is also not permitted at scrutineering or riders briefing.

MOTORISED MACHINERY/PUSHBIKES – Pushbikes, scooters, pit bikes, quads or any other motorised machinery other than competition machines are not permitted to be ridden in the pit or paddock area at ANY time. Please leave all pushbikes etc at home – they will be confiscated.

COMPETITION MACHINES - Competition machinery is not to be ridden at any time outside the boundary of the paddock, pit or track area. A helmet must be worn at all times when riding competition machine and no doubling is permitted. No riding of motorbikes up to the canteen area or behind sponsored area.

CHANGE OF MACHINERY – Change of machine may be permitted if submitted in writing to the Clerk of Course via the Race Secretary and approved at least ten (10) minutes prior to the start of the event in which the substitution is requested. Substitute machines must be eligible to compete i.e. already be entered for the meeting, have passed machine examination, be eligible for the class and replace a machine that cannot reasonably be repaired

BIKE WASH - A bike wash bay is located to the right of the track tunnel entrance, dam water is supplied here. Please be considerate to fellow campers and competitors and their belongings when washing your bikes in the pit area. **YOU CAN NOT FILL UP WITH WATER FOR BIKE WASH AT THE CLUB – YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN WATER.**

50CC DEMONSTRATION CLASS – If parents are wanting to enter the track you must be wearing hi-vis vests and must have signed the indemnity sheet. Please bring your own HiVis vest along as the club only has enough vests for marshalls. Please listen at riders briefing for special instructions as to whether the track is shortened for Demonstration riders. Please spread yourselves around the track to help **all** demo riders. Whilst we appreciate the enthusiasm of parents, we request that parent's refrain from yelling, clapping, etc as this can be distracting for the riders and can lead to accidents. Please remember that this is a demonstration class only and not a race class. There are no placings.

50CC AUTO CLASS – Please ensure all bikes comply with the required MOM's for this class. Please fully review and understand what modifications are and aren't allowed in this class.

PIT BOARD PERSONNEL – Each Senior Competitor is permitted one person in the designated pit board area. Before entering this area you are required to sign an indemnity with race secretary and be identified with a wrist band. Pit board personnel must be wearing Hi-Vis vests(must supply their own) and enclosed footwear and must be utilizing a pit board.

TRACK DESCRIPTION – The track is a hard packed track with manmade obstacles totalling 1650m in length.

IN THE EVENT OF CANCELLATION – Due to rain or similar- notifications will be posted on SEQJMX facebook & MQ Website as soon as possible. If the event is cancelled on the Friday before Saturday racing then it does not necessarily mean that Sunday is cancelled. We do have a rain out day on the calendar if it needs to be utilized.

SERIES SHIRTS – Ordered shirts can be picked up from the timing tent after round 1 each day. If we are not busy answering queries you may be able to pick them up at other times.

MEDICAL – Any Medical information should have been supplied with entries but please inform Race secretary of any recent updates. Suspended riders must supply a copy of their clearance letters at sign on to avoid disappointment.

PRESENTATION – Top three place getters in each class must be attendance at presentation to receive their medallion. 50cc demo riders will all receive a participation trophy. Prize money will be paid into nominated bank accounts.

PHOTOGRAPHY – Photographers will be taking photos over the weekend then will be placed on social media. If anyone does not want their children in these images please contact the race secretary before the event.

FUN FEATURE RACE – The first 30 riders to line up in the marshalling area behind the start gate area are eligible to participate in a FUN FEATURE RACE. Each class will get a turn over the series. This weekend is 50cc Auto and Junior Lites 2/-. This is not compulsory and is for fun only and points are not awarded towards round or series points.

We would like to thank Moreton Districts MX Club and their volunteers for hosting the Third round of the series.
