

## **Level 1 (Club Level)**

*Judge - Marshal - Measurer - Noise Control Officer (NCO) - Practice Supervisor - Race Secretary - Ride Secretary - Scrutineer - Starter - Timekeeper - Trail Boss*

1. Complete and pass online Generic Officials Seminar
2. Obtain a Blue Card
3. Apply for an Officials Licence

Some types of Level 1 Officials will need additional qualifications, as follows:-

Measurer: Will need proof of mechanic trade qualification

Noise Control Officer: will need to complete NCO Seminar

Trail Boss / Ride Secretary: Need practical experience on a minimum of three occasions.

Practice Supervisor: Attend and pass practice supervisor seminar and proof of practical experience minimum of three occasions

## **Level 2 (Interclub / Zone Level)**

*Clerk of Course - Judge - Marshal - Race Secretary - Scrutineer - Starter - Steward - Timekeeper - Referee*

- Race Secretary, Scrutineer, Clerk of Course, Steward and Referees will need to attend and pass the relevant Officials Seminar
- All level 2 officials will need to show proof of acting in the role at a minimum of three level two events (Club, Interclub, Zone).
- Officials Licence will be approved internally by MQ Office.

## **Level 3 (State Championship / National Event Level)**

*Clerk of Course - Judge - Marshal - Race Secretary - Scrutineer - Starter - Steward - Timekeeper - Referee*

- Race Secretary, Scrutineer, Clerk of Course, Steward and Referees will need to show 2 x Officials Assessments in the Role at Level 3 Meetings.
- All Level 3 Officials will need to show proof of acting in the role at a minimum of three level 2 events (Open and State Championships).
- Officials Licence will be approved by the MQ Officials Review Board

## **Level 4 (National Championship Level)**

*Clerk of Course - Judge - Marshal - Race Secretary - Scrutineer - Starter - Steward - Timekeeper - Referee*

- Steward, Referee and Clerk of Course will need to attend and pass a Key officials Seminar conducted by Motorcycling Australia.
- All officials will need to complete an Level 4 Application Form and send to MA.
- Officials Licence will be approved by Motorcycling Australia.
