

## GUIDED TOUR GUIDELINES

1.	AFFILIATION TO MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND
	Affiliate as an Associate Member Recreational Private Promoter.
	Potential affiliates must be a registered business and be able to provide an ABN.
	Due to the commercial nature of Guided Tours, operators must provide proof of work cover insurance covering any employee's or sweep riders.
	Must provide a risk management plan and emergency management plan.
2.	LEAD RIDE/TRAIL BOSS REQUIREMENTS
	The 'Lead Ride' or 'Trail Boss' must be licenced by Motorcycling Queensland and hold a current Blue Card
	Lead Ride/Trail Boss must complete either, the 'Online Generic' and attend and pass the Trail Boss seminar, <b>or</b> attain the appropriate units of competency identified in the SIS10 - Sport, Fitness and Recreation Training Package. Recognition of prior learning/experience will also be taken into consideration when accompanied with either theory
	The Lead Ride/Trail Boss must satisfy the items listed in the <u>Lead Ride/Trail Boss Responsibilities</u> and the Assistant Lead Ride/Trail Boss must also satisfy the items listed in the <u>Assistant Lead Ride/Trail Boss Responsibilities</u> .
	A Lead Ride/Trail Boss should be carrying all the equipment individual participants are required to carry ( <u>List available here</u> ) along with any of the group equipment ( <u>List available here</u> ) not being carried in other ways. The leader should have an efficient means of communicating with other trail bike tour staff and an external nonparticipating contact.
3.	SWEEP RIDER REQUIREMENTS
	Sweep rider requirements are outlined in the Sweep Rider Guidelines
	Sweep riders must complete the <u>Sweep rider sign on form</u>
4.	EVENT PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS
	Permit applications must be submitted no later than 2 weeks before the event
	A completed route must be provided with the permit application.
	All submitted permit applications agree to abide by the guidelines set out by Motorcycling Queensland and the standards outlined in the QLD Adventure Activity Standards for Trail Bike Touring.
	Permits will only be issued to those who do not have any outstanding invoices with Motorcycling Queensland.
	All participants' bikes must be registered by a State Government (RTA, QLD Transport etc.) and road worthy.
	All participants must have a current and valid State Government motorcycle licence
5.	COSTS
	No permit fee for rides 2 days in length will be incurred. Rider levy of \$30 per rider will incur. (Cost of a current Rec. Day licence & rider levy combined).
	Permit applications for more than 3 days will incur a permit fee of \$150 and a rider levy of \$30 per rider.
	Motorcycling Queensland event reporting paperwork must be submitted within 5 days after the event.
