	6.1 Changes to QLD Enduro Championships	<p>All agreed on the formation of the QLD Off-Road Championships (QORC) to consist of 9 events in 2016. The conditions to be eligible for classification in the overall QORC standings are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A riders 6 best results will count towards their overall score in the Championship.</li> <li>• Rider must be a financial member of one of the promoting clubs.</li> <li>• If an event is not using the same class structure as the official QESC classes, then the competitor will be allocated a QESC class for the purposes of points towards the series. Their points will be as per QESC classes (not a local event class), and points do not transfer between classes, if they change class during the series.</li> </ul> <p>This change falls in line with other states as well as</p>	MB to draft a one page info sheet on the changes to be included on the Supp Regs and QLD Enduro Page.

	7.1 John Hand AORC and 4 Day bid	<p>The QESC have been made aware of John Hand's grievances. According to John he was given a verbal commitment by an Enduro Commissioner that he (Gum Valley) would be awarded a round of this year's AORC, but ultimately was not.</p> <p>The QESC are unable to provide any real assistance on this matter as MA handle the awarding of national events.</p> <p>The QESC acknowledge that there is a process in place for Clubs and Promoters to apply to host events, and suggest that verbal commitments aren't usually part of this process.</p> <p>Additionally, there is some concern about what, if any, impact this might have on Gum Valley's desire / capacity to host the 2017 A4DE.</p>	Suggest MQ GM contact John Hand to see if any head-way can be made.
