	6.3 2017 Qld Offroad Series	In an endeavour to bring North, Central and Southern Queensland together. The QESC will look at a Qld Offroad Series of 9 events (taking top 6 rounds for the awards). These will be the 3 Championship rounds, the 3 Sprint rounds, and 3 rounds in Central Queensland. This will encourage the Southern riders to venture north for events and the Central and North Queensland riders to take part in a series without having to travel south for every round. Possible Central Queensland events being Yeppoon Enduro X, Benaraby Sprint and one other (possible X Country with Private Promoter).	DD to speak to Central Queensland Clubs re these events and possible dates, formats etc.
	6.4 Trophy Presentation and Awards	It was decided to have the end of year presentations in conjunction with the last round of the KTM Pony Express at the Toowoomba Motorcycling Club on the 22 nd October to cut costs and make it easier for riders to attend whilst being less formal. 	6.5 2017 A4DE	Meetings have been held with the A4DE committee, MQ, MA, Toowoomba Motorcycle club, the Enduro Sub Committee and Mr Neil Wagner re the staging of the 2017 A4DE in Toowoomba at the Wellcamp airport (over 7000 acres). All agree this is a perfect venue – application to be submitted to MA for their consideration. Toowoomba Motorcycle club and MC to look into relevant permits and dates – taking into account the Carnival of Flowers in Toowoomba and the 2017 ISDE teams returning from France in time to compete.	
7.	Strategic Development		
	7.1 Officials	Enduro is struggling State wide with a lack of officials. Subcommittee to work with MQ on strategies to address this issue.	
	7.2 Juniors	DD reported a major problem with Juniors acquiring coaching in both kickstart and re certifications as well as acquiring information from clubs on licencing (this is state wide) – Debbie is dealing with an average of 5 Juniors a week who are struggling to get into the sport through lack of club support or available information. Debbie spoke to Ray Buchanan at QMP who advised he does have a club coach on the pay role.	Talk to MQ / Board with the possibility of holding regular Kickstart and recertifications at QMP (possibly the 1st Saturday of the Month) to utilize this coach and the facility.
