		There is however, a shortage of Level 3 Enduro officials willing to assist at Enduro events.	
		The QESC therefore requests the following by approved by MQ to remain in effect until (at least) 31st December 2018:	For board / MQ approval
		*At any Qld Enduro Open (Level 3) event, as a minimum, the Clerk of Course or Steward must be accredited at Level 3 (or higher), and the roles of Scrutineer and Race Secretary (and either Clerk or Steward – whichever one isn't filled by a Level 3) can be filled by a Level 2, who will operate under the direct supervision of the Level 3 Clerk of Course or Steward.	
		This will ease the pressure on the QESC to source Officials (who we don't have) and assist with our efforts to run more Open meetings and hopefully attract more riders.	
		Queensland Enduro events don't (currently) attract the same quantity of riders that Open MX meetings do.	
		For the balance of 2018, the QESC will undertake a concerted effort to identify why there is a shortage of Level 3 Key Officials in Enduro, and implement strategies to rectify this, ie identify more / new officials, identify / offer opportunities for officials who have completed training seminars to obtain the necessary practical experience, etc.
