3.0 Previous minutes – Saturday the 26th of July at MQ Face to Face Subcommittee meeting

JR moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted, seconded by MH – Approved.

4.0 Business Arising

Discussed the fact that Cliff James has resigned from the Subcommittee - which has now caused another casual vacancy.

The subcommittee recommend that Richard Kent to be appointed to the subcommittee to fill the vacancy left after Andrew Carpenter's resignation (earlier this year). ***For MQ Board approval please.***

5.1 Inwards:

5.1.2 We received a regrading request from Bradley Bryant to be promoted to A grade which was approved as Bradley has won the youth class at the NSW titles this year and won one round of the QMTS in B grade. 5.1.3 Discussed and approved the MQ Minimum Standards to Promote Major Events document which is due to be implemented on the 1st of January 2015. We had no queries on this document.

8.0 General Business

8.1 We discussed the ties in some junior classes in the QMTS and decided to have two second place trophies in Minibike with no third and we would award two thirds place trophies in Junior.

8.2 We discussed the Women's class at the major titles as we heard that some of the women riding in the Australian, Queensland and NSW titles have been not keen to ride the sections as they are too

hard for some of the lower graded riders. They all ride the one grade lines at any title meeting. At the NSW Titles this was the B grade lines. We thought the riders could ride in their normal classes at the titles with the highest grade rider winning. This would be safer for the competitors and nowhere near as daunting. We will discuss this subject further at the next meeting.

8.3 We also discussed the need to have standard classes at all of the rounds of the QMTS. It is up to us to tell all of the clubs what classes will be in the series and get them to stick to those classes.

8.4 We discussed the need to have two training/coaching days a year for the Junior riders. Have one early in the year and one later in the year.

8.5 We discussed the sponsorship of the trophies in the QMTS from Stanfield Automatics and that JR would mail a cheque into MQ to be added to the Trials Subcommittee`s bank account. We also talked about the trophies and we will get Tracey Wager to organise the trophies. She did this last year and we were all happy with her efforts.

8.6 We discussed the need to get all the clubs calendars for next year ready and into the Subcommittee so we can sort any clashes out before the Trials Calendar goes into MQ.

We decided that we will have the next meeting at the Twinshock Masters on the 1st of November in the afternoon after the WDTC`s AGM.
