	4.1 Coaching Course	We had 17 future coaches in attendance for the MQ Coaching Course held at Rockatoo, Esk on the 12 th November, 2017. The subcommittee would like to thank Rod Jenner and John Armstrong for facilitating the course.	
	4.2 The Next Level Coaching Weekend	This turned out to be a great weekend with 9 Level 2, Level 1 and Level 0 Coaches in attendance. There was 41 riders there to be coached for the weekend. All of the Coaches had 20 hours of coaching over the weekend so all of the level '0' now have enough hours up as an assistant to apply for a Level 1 Coaches Licence. We took in \$700 in income and had \$500 of expenses for the Property, \$59 for Sausages and Onions, \$21 for Bread and \$75 for the Toilet leaving us with a \$175. 6.	General Business and Correspondence		
	6.1 Scoring system	The Sub Committee voted on and approved a Unified Scoring System to be used by all of the Trials Clubs in QLD this year. The Peter Arnold System was the one we all voted on. The cost is \$100 for each club to be paid yearly. This will be paid by the Sub Committee as it helps all of the clubs. The decision was unanimous.	GW to hand the invoice from Peter Arnold into MQ.
	6.2 Supplementary Regulations	We decided to have a new draft of the Trials Supplementary Regulations drawn up and ask all of the QLD clubs to use them as there are too many different variations getting around. This will get all of the clubs to use the same grades in all of the competitions.	
	6.3 Qld Series	We have decided to see if we can get a new QLD Series up and running for 2019. It will be called The Queensland Cup and every club will hold a round. To get an award you will have to ride all of the rounds and all of the rounds will be scored in the series. All of the grades will be the same in every round.	
	6.4 2019 Australian Trials Championships	The subcommittee does not think we should hold the Titles again so soon. We believe that Tasmania can and should hold the Titles in 2019. GW handed out the article that the Tasmanian Sub Committee has posted up on Trials Australia saying they have not refused to hold the Titles. We think if they do not hold them then it should just go to the next state in line. The reasons are it is a lot of organisation involved and a lot of people. 24 sections a day with 2 observers on each section is close to 100 people over 2 days are needed just to observe the Titles. Then there is the section setting and taping, signage and all the infrastructure needed. We held it in 2016. We would also like to hold the next one we have in some mossy creeks as this used to be a QLD thing which none of the other States hardly ever have. QMP does have some great areas to use but they are all a long way away from the car parking and the amenities at QMP.	Unanimously agreed
