	6.5 Juniors in historics	We do not approve of allowing this proposal which has been raised and dealt with in recent emails. The current rules do not permit the entry of juniors in any historic class but there seems to be an interpretation of the rule book that if it says it in the Road Race chapter then it is ok for the Historic Road Race chapter. We believe this is not the intent of the rule, and that the relevant commission should have been consulted on this prior to a determination being made by MA's staff. A letter will be drafted by Tim and sent to MA on the matter.	TH	
	6.6 RRC minutes	Me reviewed the MA Road Race Commission's meeting minutes which discussed rule change proposals. Comments as follows:  RR1280 we agree with RRC RR1281 we agree with RRC. It is too hard to regulate RR1282 we agree with RRC. It would be ideal to have a national grading system but it is very difficult to come up with a standardised system. Also it is not as necessary as it was before as less graded racing is currently happening at higher levels. Grading should be there to stop inexperienced riders entering wrong level meetings – eg. ASBK rounds at Phillip Island. So they should have a grading before they get to a nationally recognised level.  RR1183 – OK RR1184 – OK RR1186 – OK – we agree - electric machines should be catered for. RR1287 – OK RR1288 – This is not really a rule change but we agree RR1290 - we agree RR1291 – we agree RR1291 – we agree RR1292 – we agree with RRC to not recommend this change RR1293 – we agree with this proposal RR1294 – we agree with this proposal as it makes it easier to interpret the number of laps required – using FIM wording. RR1295 – we agree that the testing regime needs to be clarified. We also still wonder why we have not stuck with FIM's system of water only. RR1296 – we agree with RRC
