## **General business:**

- **QLD champs round one:**

Paul Dawson has submitted a change of use application to the Gold Coast council regarding running supermoto bikes at the upcoming round of QLD champs at Pimpana. Jovian and Paul will be having a meeting with the Gold Coast mayor regarding this.

Construction of the dirt section is going to plan. Troy Bayliss has been helping with the design of the track.

Supp regs for this event are almost finalized.

Noise testing will be done at the track in the near future and feedback will be returned to competitors so

they have a better idea of exactly what is expected of them. Holding the event without any problems will be paramount as this venue will be very important in developing the sport in SE Queensland.

Just2wheelz will be asked to do a video.

A local radio station has been approached to cover the event.

Juniors will race at both rounds of the QLD champs. S8 and S9 classes will be held. Nomination will be free for juniors at both events.

A women's class will also be run. Dependent on numbers it may be run inclusive with other classes but scored separately.

A series t-shirt will also be available.

A hotel has been organized for the Saturday night presentation event. There have also been three hotels of upper, mid and budget range approached for accommodation. A courtesy bus will be available for riders getting to and from the accommodation to the venue.

Several sponsors have been approached for the event and the series. Stay Upright will be the major sponsor. Other sponsors include Uber Moto.

The supermoto sub-committee would like to thank Paul Dawson who has been instrumental in getting this event happening.

- **Other business:**

Any QLD rider racing in the QLD champs who finishes

in the top three in their respective class will be eligible for a subsidy of \$500 from the supermoto sub-committee towards their FIM international license if they choose to go overseas.

Andy McLeish is going overseas in the near future and the supermoto sub-committee will be making a donation to help subsidize his international license.

Dave Oliver raced in New Zealand at Wanganui and Nelson and finished second in the series. His team and bike were very well presented. The sub-committee will also be making a contribution to his FIM license retrospectively.

Riders racing overseas will be encouraged to write stories for MQ to publish as MQ will pay for this. Jovian has offered to help with proof reading and offering advice.

The supermoto sub-committee will be promoting the sport through supporting riders going overseas and offering free nominations to juniors.

The recent race event at Morgan Park had a great turnout which points to a positive year ahead.

Various clubs have completed the recent national survey and the information is being worked through.
