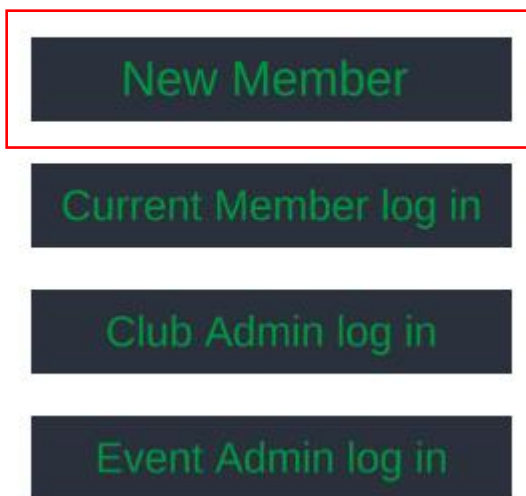

## Step 2.

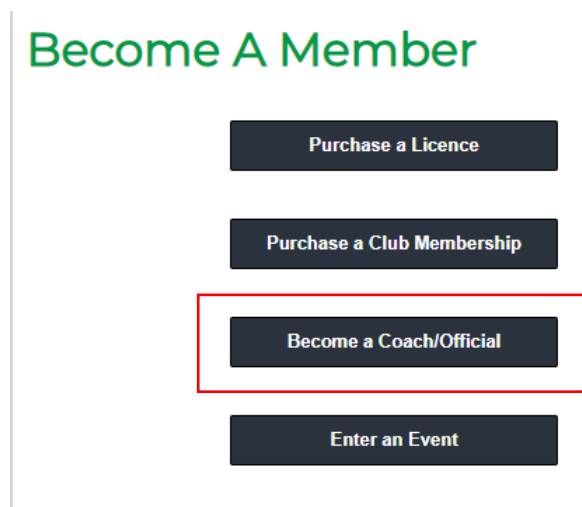
Click on “New Member”
