1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The WoW MX Series hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct 2018 WOW Motocross Interclub Series - Round 1 Motocross at the 3010 Beaudesert-Boonah Road , Coulson, QLD, 4310, AUS as per Permit Applications applied for.

2. JURISDICTION:

The above mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Queensland who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 1/18/1/82701 and is open to holders of Motorcycling Australia licences. Please see section 26 for a list of these licences.

The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling QLD.

Competitors with comparable licenses from another FMN who have obtained written clearance and provide verification of personal FIM insurance to a standard accepted by Motorcycling Australia are also eligible to compete.

3. ENTRIES:

Entries open forthwith and close on 08-Apr-2018 via Ridernet. Conditions of entries in paragraph 26.

In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the WoW MX Series, if such retention is approved by MQ. Only entries received on the official Entry Form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4. INSURANCE:

National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

1300 Medics will be in attendance from the start of racing to 15 minutes after the last race.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 6:00 AM with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

Track dissatisfaction - Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of the Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

12. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies will be awarded for first 3 places at each round. Senior Unlimited Female class will consist of A,B & C grade.

All participants in demonstration classes will receive an award.

Riders must complete in at least 2 of the 3 rounds to be eligible for series awards - a riders best 3 round results will be used when determining series awards.

Series trophies/prize money is TBA.

13. PRESENTATION

At the Completion of Racing.

14. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Motocross Competition.

Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting.

It is the competitors/parents responsibility to ensure that any machine that suffers accident damage during practice or racing is repaired and will meet the required safety standards as outlined in the MOMS prior to further participation in the event.

Capacity and fuel testing may be utilised by the Scrutineer at any round to assist with machine eligibility.

Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

15. RIDING NUMBERS:

Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's for Motocross.

16. GRID POSITIONS:

Gate Positions will be by peg draw

17. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A riders briefing will be held at 8:00 AM and prior to any on track motorcycle activity. It is compulsory for all competitors and a parent or legal guardian of all JUNIOR and under 18 competitors to attend. A random attendance roll call may be utilised by the Clerk of Course to determine a competitor's attendance at riders briefing. The Clerk of Course may at his/her discretion, penalise any competitor who is called randomly at riders briefing and is proven not to be in attendance by not responding to that call.

Smoking is strictly prohibited at Riders Briefing.

There is no restriction on tyres.

20. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.

If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known.

21. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated on the MA website - www.ma.org.au) which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

22. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Electronic Communications and Social Media Policy, found at www.ma.org.au, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behaviour where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons.

23. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

All competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behaviour contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at www.ma.org.au which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. These Codes of Behaviour apply to this meeting and will be enforced. If a rider is banned from entry at one of the participating rounds/venues they will not be allowed to ride that round of the series.

There will be an 8.30pm curfew for children under 16 years of age camping at the track on both Friday and Saturday evenings. All children must be back at their own camp by 8.30pm. Failure to comply may result in penalties ranging from fines to exclusion from the meeting. Please note the venue is under the control of meeting officials from gates open Friday to gates closed on Sunday afternoon.

Natural Terrain Motocross Track - 1.4km in length

26. RESTRICTIONS

The above mentioned meeting has been authorised by MQ who has issued a Motorcycling Australia Permit Number and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National or One Event Licences (OEL to junior riders if they hold a current JCP Log Book), who are full financial members of the Promoting Club (no discount or one day memberships are allowed).

One Event Licences are available in Ridernet when you enter this event.

The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by MQ.

- **Entries**

Are via Ridernet. Entries will be accepted on the day via an entry form.

- **ELECTRONIC TIMING**

My Laps will be utilised at each round and is compulsory for all competitors in practice and racing sessions. A hire fee of \$15 per transponder will be charged unless a valid My Laps transponder is supplied. Brackets are on sale for \$10. Transponders may be shared between multiple bikes but the onus is on the rider to have that transponder fitted at all times, this includes practice sessions. If transponder is not attached to competing bike then that rider may not be scored. Transponders can be purchased with entry or directly from My Laps. A hire purchase option is available through MQ but the onus is on the competitor to keep receipts for proof. Loss or damage to a hired transponder incurs a fee up to \$330. The promoter is not responsible for any lost transponders.

- Hired transponders will be exchanged for MA licences and can be picked up at sign on. For transponders not returned on the same day a fee of \$20 per day may be charged. Please contact Race Secretary to arrange return of hired transponders.
- No animals are permitted at any event unless it is for a visually impaired person.
- All push bikes or motorised pit bikes or similar are not permitted at the event at any time.
- Generators are to be turned off by 10pm, unless notified otherwise.
- All junior riders must be back at their own camp by 8pm. Noise must be kept to a minimum for the quiet enjoyment of all.

- **FLAGGIES**

All entrants are required to supply one volunteer for one round of either practice or racing over the weekend.

- **REFUND POLICY**

Full refunds will be given to riders supplying medical certificates. Any rider requesting refund after the event without a medical certificate will not receive a refund. Requests for refunds at least one week prior to the event will receive a full refund but requests for refunds within the week prior to the event MAY receive a refund at the discretion of the race secretary but there will be a deduction of \$25 administration fee. If you purchase a One Event Licence it will be refunded.

- **CANCELLATION OR CHANGE OF VENUE :** Cancellation, postponement or change of venue is at the discretion of event organisers in conjunction with participating clubs and Motocross sub-committee. Competitors will be notified by email and on social media at least one week from scheduled round for a change of venue. Notification of cancellation or postponement will be given with as much notice as possible. A refund will not be given for change of venue.
- Entrants of this event must comply with rules and regulations of Qld Moto Park.
