**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

Central Burnett MCC, Keppel Coast Dirt Bike Club and Gladstone District Dirtriders, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct a three round Orange to Ocean 2008 Interclub Series for Senior riders in Open, Lites, and Unlimited Classes and Junior riders in Junior Lites, Mini Lites, 65cc and 50cc classes, and also Senior riders in Quads. The promotion is on behalf of the clubs and at the venues and dates listed above.

**2. JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The above mentioned meetings have been authorised by Motorcycling Qld who has issued the Motorcycling Australia permit numbers 38615 / 38616 / 38617 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Club, Nipper and One Meeting Licences - who are financial members of one of the promoting clubs. (no one day membership allowed)
- 2.2. These race meetings will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling Qld.  
**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

**3. ENTRIES:**

- 3.1. Series entries open forthwith and close last mail 9 January.. Entries for each round will also be accepted on the day of the race meeting at each round.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoter if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Qld.
- 3.3. For series entries, only entries received at PO Box 718, Gladstone Qld 4680 on the official Entry Form by last mail Wednesday, 9 January that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB PROMOTING THAT ROUND.**

**4. INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. ***IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.***

**5. MEDICAL SERVICES:**

QAS and / or other qualified first aid personnel will be in attendance at each race meeting, from the start of practice until fifteen minutes after the last race.

## 6. ENTRY FEE

- 6.1. **Series entry fees** (Munduberra, Yeppoon and Gladstone) will be \$95 for seniors, \$80 for juniors, \$65 for 50cc, \$35 for Demonstration class. There is a \$10 discount per class for a series entry. Competitors are encouraged to submit a series entry. Payment for Series Entries are to be made out to Gladstone District Dirtriders and posted to PO Box 718, Gladstone, 4680.  
**Entry fees at each round** will be, senior riders \$35, junior classes \$30, 50cc \$25, Demo class \$15. Senior second nomination will be \$35 and all junior second nominations will be \$30. Payment at each round is to be made to the host club.
- 6.2. Payment by Cash, Money Order, Bank or Post Office cheque only. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**

## 8 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies, prizes and awards will be presented on the day as well as end of series awards, presented at the final round. All 50cc Div 1 will receive a participation award.

Prize Money at each round: Seniors: 1<sup>st</sup> \$45, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$35, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$25, 4<sup>th</sup> \$10

Juniors: 1<sup>st</sup> \$40, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$30, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$20, 4<sup>th</sup> \$10

Series Awards: An award will be presented at the final round for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters of each class (excluding demonstration classes).

## 9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 9.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be six (6).  
9.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the promoter subject to Motorcycling Qld approval.

## 10 RACE FORMAT:

Race Format will be as per paragraph seven (7).

## 11 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs.  
11.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.  
11.3. Change of rider or machine (not both) may be permitted if submitted in writing to the Clerk of Course and with the approval of the M.A. Steward at least ten (10) minutes prior to the start of the event in which the substitute is requested.  
11.4. Substitute rider must be eligible to compete, ie. - Already entered for the meeting and be the correct grade or if not entered substitution must be made at machinery with a new entry form. Substitute machine must have passed machine examination, be eligible for the class and replace a machine that cannot be reasonably repaired.  
11.5. There will be no more than 20 competitors in the Quads Class.

## **12 RIDING NUMBERS:**

- 12.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number or their preferred Riding Number. All others will be allocated numbers at each promoter's discretion.
- 12.2. Legible back numbers corresponding with the competing machine's number are compulsory for junior competitors and it is requested that all competitors have them.

## **13 GRID POSITIONS:**

For the first leg at each round all positions will be by peg draw, then riders will be called as per finishing position in the previous leg unless otherwise announced at riders briefing.

## **14 RIDERS BRIEFING:**

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice at each round and ALL Competitors MUST attend Riders Briefing.

## **15 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**

- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the promoting club discretion until the results of the tests are known.

## **16 CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to all Meetings and will be enforced.

## **17 TIMETABLE:**

A time will be made available during scrutineering for competitors to walk the track.

*For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing*, the commencement of the meetings will be deemed to be 7.00AM with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

## **18 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**

RIVERSIDE RACEWAY at Mundubbera is mostly natural terrain close to the Burnett River. Loamy soil with large drop aways and some man made jumps and berms. Anticlockwise racing. Camping permitted. Track has shower and toilet facilities.

COASTAL PARK RACEWAY YEPPOON is 1700mts long and is sandy clay soil with man made jumps and runs in an anti-clockwise direction. The track is 5 minutes before the town of Yeppoon, access is via the refuse station road. Signs will be erected. Camping permitted, bring fresh water.

BENARABY MX RACEWAY is 1500mts in length consisting of clay soil with man made obstacles. Racing is in clockwise direction. Camping permitted. Track has shower and toilet facilities. Bring fresh water.

### **STARTS:**

Motocross Starts will be by a maximum of forty (40) self-penalising gates. A two-minute board will be displayed and competitors must be ready to start after the two minutes as per the GCRs. After this time a 15/5-second board will be used with the gate dropping a minimum of 5 seconds after the 5 seconds board is displayed. Starts may not be delayed after the two minutes has expired.

**19 RACING:**

There will be 5 laps or 10 minutes of practice offered per class which ever is the lessor / per race meeting.

Race format will be as per paragraph seven (7).

The maximum number of riders for practice will be 125% of the number of gates.

**21. NOISE:**As per GCRs

**22. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:**

- 22.1 Junior Lites is (87cc to 100ccBW, 125cc two stroke and 250cc four stroke) machine. No 85cc BW permitted in the Junior Lites Class.
- 22.2 The Clubman Lites / Senior Lites is (125cc two stroke and up to 250cc four stroke).
- 22.3 The Clubman / Senior Open is (127cc two stroke up to 510cc and 255cc four stroke up to 663cc.
- 22.4 The Senior Lites and Open classes:- depending on nominations, Clubman may be run as a separate race or a qualifier may be held prior to the start of racing, with qualifiers to fill the Lites or Open grids. Non qualifiers will ride a separate race (for no points or prizemoney) which may be run with another class.
- 22.5 The 85cc 12 - 15 yrs is open to standard wheel (SW) or big wheel motorcycle (BW) and 150cc 4 stroke machines, the 85cc 9 - 11 yrs is only open to standard wheel motorcycle (SW).
- 22.6 A junior rider's age on January 1 will determine his/her age for competition that year. However, a rider may move to the next higher class when he/she becomes eligible to do so at any time during the year, but once a rider moves to the higher age class in any competition, he/she may not move back to the lower age class. Points earned in a lower class will not transfer to the higher class. This rule will apply to all riders up to and including 16 year olds.
- 22.7 Numbers permitting, any class may be run with a comparable class.
- 22.8 Staggered start may be used for some or all classes.
- 22.9 Events will run as near as practical to the stated time and may finish just short if necessary.
- 22.10 **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Flag Marshals or MA Officials. Each competitor is required to nominate a representative at each round. A flag marshal's roster will be drawn up and upon request that representative must be able to act as a flag marshal or official. Failure to supply a representative upon request may mean exclusion for the rider/s.

Admission will be at the discretion of the host clubs, but will be a maximum of \$6 per car.

**CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2008 ORANGE TO OCEAN INTERCLUB SERIES**

**WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.**

**1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below):** [Insert Name]

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

**2. DEFINITIONS** In this declaration:

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

**3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS**

- I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
    - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
    - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
    - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
    - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
    - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
    - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
    - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
    - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
  - b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
  - c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
  - d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

**4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)**

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:
 

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

 Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

**NOTE:** The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004. For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

**5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS**

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
  - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
  - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
  - iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever;
- b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- 6. The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- 7. A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

**8. MEDICAL**

I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

**10. PRIVACY**

I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the Promoter/Event Organiser, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Event Organiser, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by contacting MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

**11. PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION**

I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- a) I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
  - i) If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related

information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information:

- ii) MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport; and
- iii) It is reasonable for MA and my SCB to collect, store, use and disclose my Information in accordance with clause 11(a)(i) above and in the manner set out in clause 11(b).
- b) IN CONSIDERATION of my acceptance as an entrant in the Meeting I consent and agree that MA and my SCB:
  - i) may collect and store any of my Information, including obtain my Information from third parties including my Carers;
  - ii) may use any information collected in accordance with this clause for any purpose consistent with creating safer competition in motorcycle sport and events held by or in conjunction with MA, my SCB, or with an MA or SCB permit;
  - iii) may disclose my Information to third parties provided such disclosure is reasonably intended to be used for the purpose of improving safety at events held by or in conjunction with MA, or with an MA permit provided any such information is held by MA or my SCB in accordance with the MA Privacy Policy;
  - c) I irrevocably authorise MA and my SCB and hereby appoint MA and my SCB as my lawful attorneys to collect from my Carers, and I hereby direct my Carers to provide to MA or my SCB upon request being made by MA or my SCB, any of my Information including but not limited to any information concerning any incident or event causing or contributing to or resulting from any injury, illness or death to me, the details of any diagnosis and prognosis provided to me by my Carers (or any party with the knowledge of any of my Carers), and any other matter to the knowledge of my Carers that might reasonably be considered to be requested by MA or my SCB for the purpose of improving safety at MA and SCB events.

**12. POLICIES AND REGULATIONS**
