



2006 CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARD

Rationale:

In 2003 Motorcycling Queensland replaced the award previously known as the 'Club Development' award with the 'Club of the Year' award. The purpose of this document is to provide MQ affiliated Clubs with the guidelines by which this award will be allocated in 2006.

The winning Club will be the Club that accrues the most points during the allocated time frame.

Purpose:

- To recognise and reward Clubs that perform both on and off the track in 2006.
- To encourage Clubs to improve their administration in 2006.
- To recognise administrators of Clubs for their outstanding service to the sport and their Club.

Timing:

The 2006 Award winner will be determined by points accrued from the period:
1st November 2006 through until 31st October 2006.

Presentation:

The winners of this award for 2006 will be presented with their awards at the 2006 Motorcycling Queensland Awards Night.

Award:

1st place

Club Affiliation to be paid for by MQ for the following year (2007).

Trophy to be presented recognising 1st place.

Named on the MQ perpetual shield as the Club Development award winner for 2006.

2 x tickets to the 2006 MQ Night of Champions Awards Night.

2nd place

Trophy to be presented recognising 2nd place.

2 x tickets to the 2006 MQ Night of Champions Awards Night.

3rd place

Trophy to be presented recognising 3rd place.

2 x tickets to the 2006 MQ Night of Champions Awards Night.

Other Awards:

An award is also presented to the "Most Improved Club" (biggest positive points difference from 2005 to 2006), the winner of this award will receive: a trophy recognising this achievement, noted on newly created perpetual shield, and 2 x tickets to 2006 MQ Awards Night.

24. A club will lose 100 points for every month any invoice 60 days and over owing to MQ.	(100)

25. A mark out of 100 to be decided by MQ staff in regard to each club's efficiency and effectiveness in dealing with the office	100
