### 2. SIGN ON

Competitors will be required to present their competition Licence and logbook (Juniors) to the Sign On personnel. SHELL ADVANCE decals and programs will be supplied at sign on. Incomplete entry forms will be finalised at Sign on.

### 7. SPONSOR STICKERS

"SHELL ADVANCE" stickers will be provided at Scrutineering/SIGN ON. The large "SHELL ADVANCE" decal **MUST** be on the front guard of all machines. Machines without the "SHELL ADVANCE" decal will not be allowed onto the Start Gates.

### 3. SCRUTINEERING –

**Machines, helmets and body armour are to be presented at scrutineering.**

Saturday and Sunday scrutineering will start at 6.30am  
Scrutineering will take place in the following group lines:  
SATURDAY : 65'S, 85'S, Lites, Opens  
SUNDAY : 85's, Junior Lites, Intermediate, Expert, Pro

### 8. SPARE MACHINES

AS per item 12.3 of the Supplementary Regulations, spare machines must be scrutineered and must have been entered into the event via the entry form.

### 4. TRANSPONDERS

Competitors will be required to exchange their Competition Licence for a timing transponder. Please refer to Item 24 of the Supplementary Regulations for details of transponder returns and penalties associated with late or non return.

### 9. REFUNDS

Refunds are as per supplementary regulations.

### 5. ADMISSION

If you enter via [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au), you will have received your QMX entry receipt via email. This receipt represents your ticket. Please bring this receipt to gain access to the circuit. The receipt will entitle the following number of persons for entry : Junior Competitor – 3 persons, Senior competitor – 2 persons. Your receipt will be collected by the gatekeeper. Manual entry forms will receive passes via mail. Extra passes are available at the gate as a gold coin donation – please give generously .

### 10. NOISE

All machines must comply with the current MOM's for noise emissions. Testing may be undertaken at any time throughout any round of this series. Penalties may be applied for machines which do not pass.

**NO PASS or RECEIPT presented will require you to pay the full admission cost – NO EXCEPTIONS will be made. Any person found to present multiple copies to gain admission will be reprimanded.**

### 11. NOISE CURFEW

**No machine is to be started prior to the commencement of first practice on both Saturday and Sunday.**

### 6. RIDERS BRIEFING

Rider Briefing will be held at the at the Start Gates. The first practice group on each day is requested to be sitting on their bikes in front of the start gates with helmets removed ready to commence as soon as briefing is completed. Machines participating in the first practice are to be pushed to Rider Briefing as a safety precaution. Riders Briefing is **COMPULSORY**.

### 12. TIME SCHEDULE CHANGES

Please check the time schedule. SIGN ON times have been brought forward from round 1 and race order may have be altered. Order of practice will be the same as Race 1 for each class.

### 13. PIT BOARD PERSONNEL

Each Senior competitor is permitted one (1) person in the designated pit board area. This person will be required to Sign On with the Race Secretary and be given an armband for identification. Sign on will be available 5 mins AFTER Riders Briefing. Personnel must be over 18 and be utilising a pitboard and wearing closed toed footwear. The Clerk of course reserves the right to remove any person from the Signalling Area.

### 14. ALCOHOL

The carrying of and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages by any person within the pit or paddock area is strictly prohibited. **ANY** person includes, spectators, parents, competitors, officials and team personnel.

Pushbikes, Scooters, pit bikes, quads, or any other motorised machinery other than competition machines are not permitted to be ridden in the pit or paddock area at any time during the duration of the event permit. This includes from gates open on Friday until gates close on Sunday. Any person found doing so may have the device confiscated

## 16. CAMPING

Camping is permitted at the track. It is a privilege to be able to camp at the track. The camping area will be signed. The Clubs directions in this regard must be followed at all times. Generators utilised for camping must be shut down by 10.00pm. Showers are available. Water tanks supply limited fresh showers.

Children under the age of 16 years will be required to adhere to an 8.30pm curfew. They must be at their own campsite by this time, if not, penalties may apply.

Due to vandalism at a previous round – this is the first and final warning. If there is any unruly behaviour or further vandalism, those found being offensive will be removed from the meeting and no further camping will be allowed at the Shell Advance Sunshine State Motocross Series for 2010.

Those found to bunt off excessive area's will be requested to "downsize" their pit area as there are multiple persons using the area.

## 17. RIDERS LISTS

Riders lists will be available from Motorcycling Qld MX Mini site [www.mqld.org.au](http://www.mqld.org.au) – motocross live feed.

## 18. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be available for collection from the Race Secretary approximately 30 minutes after each classes last event. Junior competitors must have their parent/guardian collect and sign for any prizemoney awards. If you forget to pick up your prize money, please email [katherine.rumble@bigpond.com](mailto:katherine.rumble@bigpond.com) with your bank details so the money can be direct debited to your account.

## 19. GATES OPEN AND PIT AREAS

Gates open AT 4PM FRIDAY – NO EARLIER. There is strictly no bunting off or marking of any areas. Areas are to be for yourself only, NO "SAVING" space for other persons. First in First served basis. Excessive area's will be reduced by Club personnel. Any person found not complying with the Clubs directions may be reprimanded or fined.

## 20. RESERVE RIDERS

Reserve riders will be notified prior to the meeting whether sufficient withdrawals have been received to enable them to compete. If a competitor withdraws from the meeting during the race day they are requested to advise the Race Secretary to enable a reserve rider the opportunity to compete. A reserve rider may attend the

meeting on the chance that a late withdrawal may enable them to compete. A reserve rider may participate in practice. Reserve riders may wait in the marshalling area during the allocation of gate pegs. If a gate is vacant at the two minute board, the first reserve may take this gate at the direction of the marshal.

However if the programmed rider arrives prior to the 15 second board then the reserve must relinquish the gate. If a reserve rider gets to compete in any race on the day, this does not guarantee a start in subsequent races.

## 21. JUNIOR and MINOR COMPETITORS

Juniors (under 16) and Minors (COMPETITORS UNDER 18 BUT OVER 16)

Parents of competitors under the age of 18 years are reminded that if they are not attending the event with their child, they **MUST** provide a signed MA Guardianship form to the person who is. A Guardianship form must be provided for the child to be able to participate.

## 22. HELMET CAMERAS

Helmet cameras are NOT allowed.

### NOTE :

Toowoomba went well, Saturday got a bit dusty, Sunday the track held up. The Shell Series seems to have rebound momentum. Shirts will be available at the final Round – Sorry – Next year I endeavour to have them available at the First Round. If you have any comments please feel free to come and visit me – I will be situated somewhere near the canteen and timing.

As we appreciate everyone is time poor; Presentation for the Series will be held at Tivoli over the two days – Saturday Race Classes will be presented on Saturday afternoon immediately proceeding the Racing. Sunday presentation will be Sunday afternoon immediately after the racing. The club will have a sausage sizzle and drinks for purchase. More detail will come in the Tivoli Final instructions.
