2. PASSES

Competitors Passes, SHELL ADVANCE stickers will be available for collection at a Ticket Collection Quickshade prior to Entry to the Track. The responsibility of pass collection is with the competitor. No pass no entry and the club will charge and entry fee at the gate. For competitors that are camping – please collect your passes on Saturday morning. We ask that Sunday competitors are welcome to come and watch on Saturday, however, due to the limited parking space, trailers can't be bought in until after 3pm

There will be someone at the Ticket Collection Quickshade from

Friday : 2.00pm – 4.00pm.

Saturday : 6.00am 3.30pm

Sunday : 6.00am – 8.00am – all competitor passes should be picked up by this time.

3. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will take place in the following group lines:

SATURDAY : 65'S, 85'S, Lites, Opens

SUNDAY : 85's, Junior Lites, Intermediate, Expert, Pro

4. TRANSPONDERS

Competitors will be required to exchange their Competition Licence for a timing transponder. Please refer to Item 24 of the Supplementary Regulations for details of transponder returns and penalties associated with late or non return.

5. ADMISSION

Is by competitor pass only. No pass means you will need to pay.





6. RIDERS BRIEFING

Rider Briefing will be held at the base of the Control Tower at the Start Finish Straight. The first practice group on each day is requested to be sitting on their bikes in front of the start gates with helmets removed ready to commence as soon as briefing is completed. Machines participating in the first practice are to be pushed to Rider Briefing as a safety precaution. Riders Briefing is COMPULSORY.

7. SPONSOR STICKERS

"Shell Advance" stickers will be provided at Scrutineering. The large "SHELL ADVANCE" decal MUST be on the front guard of all machines. Machines without the "SHELL ADVANCE" decal will not be allowed onto the Start Gates.

8. SPARE MACHINES

AS per item 12.3 of the Supplementary Regulations, spare machines must be scrutineered and must have been entered into the event via the entry form.

9. REFUNDS

Refunds will be processed as per Item 3.11 of the Supplementary Regulations.

10. ALCOHOL

The carrying of and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages by any person within the pit or paddock area is strictly prohibited. **ANY** person includes, spectators, parents, competitors, officials and team personnel.

11. MOTORISED MACHINERY/PUSHBIKES

Pushbikes, Scooters, pit bikes, quads, or any other motorised machinery other than competition machines are not permitted to be ridden in the pit or paddock area at any time during the duration of the event permit. This includes from gates open on Friday until gates close on Sunday.

12. COMPETITION MACHINES

Competition machinery is not to be ridden at anytime outside the boundary of the paddock, pit or track area. No exceptions.

13. CAMPING/ACCOMMODATION

Camping is permitted at the track. Their directions in this regard must be followed at all times. Generators utilised for camping must be shut down by 10.00pm. Hot Showers are available. Water tanks supply limited fresh showers.

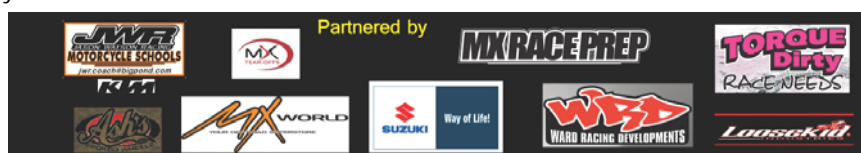
Children under the age of 16 years will be required to adhere to an 8.30pm curfew. They must be at their own campsite by this time, if not, penalties may apply.

14. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be available for collection from the Race Secretary approximately 30 minutes after each classes last event. Junior competitors must have their parent/guardian collect and sign for any prizemoney awards. If you forget to pick up your prize money, please email katherine.rumble@bigpond.com with your bank details so the money can be direct debited to your account.

15. LOCAL AUTHORITIES

Local Police have requested that competitors be placed on notice – any unruly post event behaviour out within the community will not be tolerated.





16. JUNIOR COMPETITORS

Parents of competitors under the age of 18 years are reminded that if they are not attending the event with their child, they **MUST** provide a signed MA Guardianship form to the person who is. A Guardianship form must be provided for the child to be able to participate.

18. PIT AREA

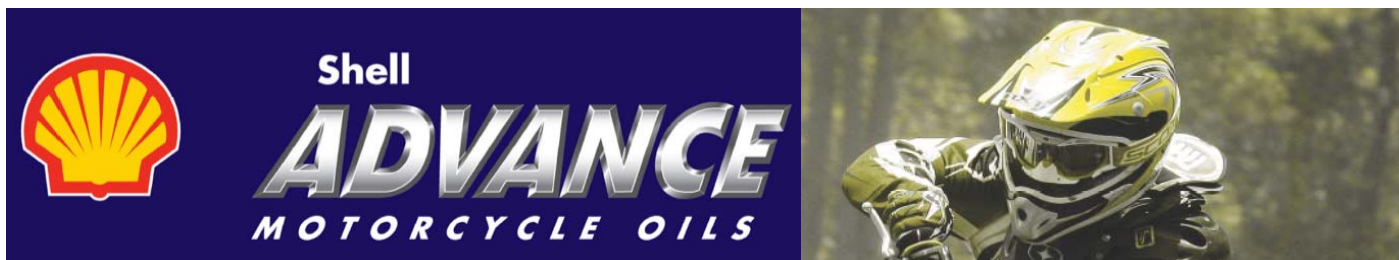
Do not drive pegs into to any bitumen surface.
