One Event International Licence

MA will cover the cost of the One Event International Licence required to compete in this event (approx \$300.00). Once MA has nominated the Wildcards for approval by the FIM, event entry forms will be sent out.

Requirement

The FIM has allocated MA three Wildcards for both the 125GP and Moto2 classes. To be eligible for consideration, Wildcards must fulfil the following:

- Must be born after **1 January 1984** and before **17 October 1994** (125GP only)
- Must be born after **1 January 1981** and before **17 October 1993** (Moto2 only)
- Competed in a National Championship and/or an International events (125GP only)
- Must not have ridden in the event as a Wildcard on 3 previous occasions in the same class
- Riders who are granted a Wildcard will not be permitted to compete in the National Support Races
- Helmets must be of the full face type and conform to one of the recognised international standards:
 - Europe ECE 22-05 'P'
 - Japan JIS T 8133 : 2000
 - USA SNELL M 2005



PLEASE NOTE: Final approval of all Wildcards is made by the FIM. A Wildcard ride is only granted upon written confirmation from the FIM to MA. The FIM and MA have the right to select any rider they deem appropriate for this event.
